WORFLC to establish transitional housing to benefit families in crisis

GARFIELD HEIGHTS (June 04, 2010) – Word of Righteousness Family Life Center, Inc. (www.worflc.org), a faith-based non-profit organization dedicated to providing quality support services to enrich the lives of families throughout Northeast Ohio, was selected by Cleveland Restoration Group, LLC to receive the generous donation of a violation-free home.

Word of Righteousness Family Life Center (WORFLC) and Cleveland Restoration Group, LLC, together with collaborative partners throughout the community, will prepare the home to provide emergency housing for families in transition. As a result of this joint effort, children and parents at risk of homelessness can be compassionately assisted with supportive services from within their community. Upon stabilizing the families with temporary housing, WORFLC staff will implement the wrap-around process with interested families to empower them and promote self-sufficiency.

“On countless occasions we have worked with families in an attempt to obtain financial assistance through various emergency housing programs offered by our community partners. However, when clients are unable to meet the eligibility requirements, they may need to relocate to a shelter, though it can be difficult to make such an arrangement for families, especially during weekends or holidays. Ultimately, when all other resources are unavailable, a family might be placed in a hotel to accommodate the need for shelter. The receipt of this generous donation affords our organization with a valuable alternative to meet the growing need for emergency housing in support of the families we serve,” stated Dr. Alicia M. Lytle, President and Chief Executive Officer of WORFLC.

- * distributing hundreds of coats and clothing items, as well as hundreds of toys, to families
- * offering hundreds of individuals with supportive services, including parenting training, life skills and group support
- * connecting countless other families to valuable resources and linkages within the community

The grassroots non-profit has developed a reputation for genuinely collaborating to meet the needs and provide resources to the community. It plans to seek community support to cover the overhead costs, maintenance and upkeep of the donated property.
